WINTER FOOTWEAR

With winter weather here, it is time to review the school's policy on appropriate footwear. Because we run around on a daily basis, we do ask that you send your child in gym shoes every day. Boots (both rain and snow) make it hard for children to engage in gross motor activities safely, as well as sit comfortably on the rug. Since children like to splash in every puddle they see and walk through as much snow as possible, I know that wearing boots to and from the car is necessary. We have placed a boot tray near the double doors to the preschool, when you come in, please feel free to use room 5 to change your child out of boots and into inside shoes. You may place the rain/snow boots in the tray to reverse the process at dismissal time. We understand that this may take a few extra minutes of your time at both drop off and dismissal, and we appreciate your understanding.
