# **INDOOR GYM**

We will begin indoor gym this month. Students MUST be in tennis shoes to participate as the floor is not safe to run in fashion shoes and boots.

## WINTER FOOTWEAR

With winter weather here, it is time to review the school's policy on appropriate footwear. Because we run around on a daily basis, we do ask that you send your child in gym shoes every day. Boots (both rain and snow) make it hard for children to engage in gross motor activities safely, as well as sit comfortably on the rug. Since we will still be going outside to play, children may bring boots to change into before we head outside. If your child comes in boots and does not bring shoes in his/her backpack, we will call you to drop some off at the preschool door.

#### PARENT TEACHER CONFERENCES

Just a reminder that we have parent-teacher conferences coming up this month, please check to make sure you remember your time slot. Please enter the building at the downstairs preschool door, all other doors will remain locked. We do have childcare for conferences that occur during the normal school hours: 8:30-3:30.
